Please join us for A Valentine's Preview, including Vivaldi's *Winter*, from his most popular work, *The Four Seasons*, Tchaikovsky's *Waltz* from *Serenade for Strings*, Mozart *Allegro Maestoso* and John Dowland's *Suite for Strings*. This program also features one of the 20th centuries' most important composers: Igor Stravinsky. *Ragtime*, is a dedication to American jazz; a work he wrote before actually hearing this new musical idiom that was raging across the Atlantic Ocean. Vivaldi's *Four Seasons* was written as four violin concerti, and this performance of *Winter* will feature Soprano Violinist of the Hutchins Consort, Beth Folsom. A former member of the San Diego Symphony, Beth is one of the most passionate and exciting string players in Southern California. Contemporary of Shakespeare, composer and luthier, John Dowland's *Suite of songs* includes *King of Denmark*, *Captain Digorie Piper's Galliard*, *Pavane*, and the hauntingly beautiful "Stairway to Heaven" of the early 17th century, *Lachrimae Antiquae (Ancient Tears)*. Join us for an entrancing evening of unique string sound.
